

BRIEF HISTORY OF BARANGAY CONCEPCION

Barangay Concepcion is one of the 21 Barangays of the Municipality of Bacolor with a total Land Area of 245 hectares or about 8.45 % of the entire municipality area and rank 10th in terms of size. It is located in the northern part of Bacolor and about 5 kilometers away from the town proper. Barangay Concepcion is also one of the predominantly agriculture area with rice and sugarcane as the main product.

Concepcion was officially a part of Barangay San Antonio but its population increased as time passed. It was made into a separate Barrio called Concepcion which derived from its Patron Saint the Immaculate Concepcion. As to structure about 80% of area was devastated by the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo and its subsequent Lahar flow from 1992-1995.
