This act took effect upon the arrival on June 18, 1952 at this point Mr. Leonardo Nunag was appointed in Barangay Parulog through his effort Primary School was established in the community. The succeeding administration was elected by the people in the name of the late Higinio Escoto, Sr. He was responsible for the Barangay to become independent upon the petition of the inhabitants it was granted through a Resolution by the assistance all Government Agencies.
